CLAT 2020 (Common Law Admission Test) is an All India common entrance test which is conducted on a rotational basis by 19 National Law Universities (NLUs) for admissions to their UG and PG degree programmes. There is no upper age limit to apply for the entrance test. CLAT is a computer-based test which will consist of MCQ type questions. The score of CLAT 2020 will be accepted by the 22 NLUs and the institutions having Memorandum of Understanding (MoU). CLAT 2020 Application Form

The application form is availed at the CLAT official website, mode of filling the application form will be online. Candidate needs to fill the valid details in the application form. Steps involved in filling the application form will be- Personal details, Qualification details, Uploading of signature and photograph, Payment. A link to fill the application form is also provided below for the ease of candidate.

Application Fee

The below-mentioned fee details are based as per the last year fee details.

- Rs. 4000/- for General/OBC/PWD/NRI/PIO/OCI candidates.
- Rs. 3500/- for SC/ST/BPL category candidates.

How to Register

- Firstly visit the CLAT 2020 official website.
- From there click at the link in which Click Here For New Registration is mentioned. The
 registration page will open, mention the name, email ID and mobile number for the
 registration. Provisional Registration Number and Password will be generated after
 filling the asked details.
- Know candidate need to asses the login by mentioning his/her Registration Number and Password. After accessing the log in the candidate will be able to fill out the application form.
- Candidate needs to fill the personal details, qualification details, contact details and click at the submit button.
- After clicking on the submit button, next page will open at that page candidate will need to upload the scanned passport size photograph, signature and scanned documents and click at the submit button.
- After clicking on the submit button, payment page will open. The candidate needs to pay the application form fee by using bank Challan or via Credit Card, Debit Card or Internet Banking.
- After the successful registration of the application form candidate will receive the confirmation E-mail or SMS at there registered mail ID and number.

CLAT 2020 Eligibility Criteria

Eligibility criteria for CLAT 2020 are divided into two section, one is for undergraduates and another one is postgraduates. Candidate can check the eligibility criteria from the below-mentioned information.

Eligibility Criteria for Undergraduates

Age

1. There will be no age limit for CLAT 2020.

Qualification Criteria

- Candidate should be 12th pass by scoring minimum 45% aggregate for General / OBC / PWD / NRI / PIO / OCI categories.
- 2. Candidate should be 12th pass by scoring minimum 40% aggregate for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe (SC/ST) categories.
- Candidates who are appearing in the 12th examination in March/April 2020 are also eligible to appear in CLAT-2020 entrance examination but the candidate needs to should show the evidence of their passing the qualifying examination at the time of admission.

CLAT 2020 Admit Card

CLAT 2020 Admit Card is availed to the candidate after after successful submission of application form. Candidate needs to check the mentioned details in the admit card first if any incorrect details are mentioned in the admit card then that candidate should immediately contact to the releasing authority of the CLAT 2020. Candidate needs to bring the one valid ID proof (Adhar Card, Pan Card, Driving Licence, Voter ID Card) and a hard copy of a admit card.

How to Download CLAT Admit Card?

- Firstly visit the CLAT 2020 official website.
- Log in by entering your registration number and password.
- Click on the submit button.
- After clicking on the submit button candidate's admit card page will get open.
- Download option will be there by clicking on the download option candidate can download his/her admit card.

CLAT 2020 Exam Pattern

CLAT 2020 Syllabus

Candidate should know about the examination syllabus for the preparation of the exam. From the syllabus, candidate knows about the specified topics that what to be prepared for the examination. Candidates can see the CLAT 2020 syllabus from below-

- For UG Programmes
- 1. **English Language-** Includes correction of incorrect grammatical sentences, filling in the blanks in sentences with appropriate words, etc.
- 2. **General Knowledge and Current Affairs-** Includes national and international current affairs and GK
- 3. **Quantitative Techniques-**The Quantitative Techniques section of the UG-CLAT 2020 will include short sets of facts or propositions, graphs, or other textual, pictorial or diagrammatic representations of numerical information, followed by a series of questions. You will be required to derive information from such passages, graphs, or other representations, and apply mathematical operations on such information..
- 4. **Legal Reasoning-** Includes legal propositions and a set of facts to which the said proposition has to be applied. Some propositions may not be "true" in the real sense, candidates will have to assume the "truth" of these propositions and answer the questions accordingly.
- 5. **Logical Reasoning-** Includes logical reasoning questions such as syllogisms, logical sequences, analogies, etc
